We require sites to store specimens at -80°C (-70°C to -90°C) and ship them to us in batches. This helps reduce Styrofoam waste. We will send only one large Styrofoam shipping container per kit request. Note: if you are unable to ship in batches but are willing to provide your own Styrofoam shipping boxes for subsequent shipments, please select 'yes'.
